

Pupil Premium Report 2020-2021

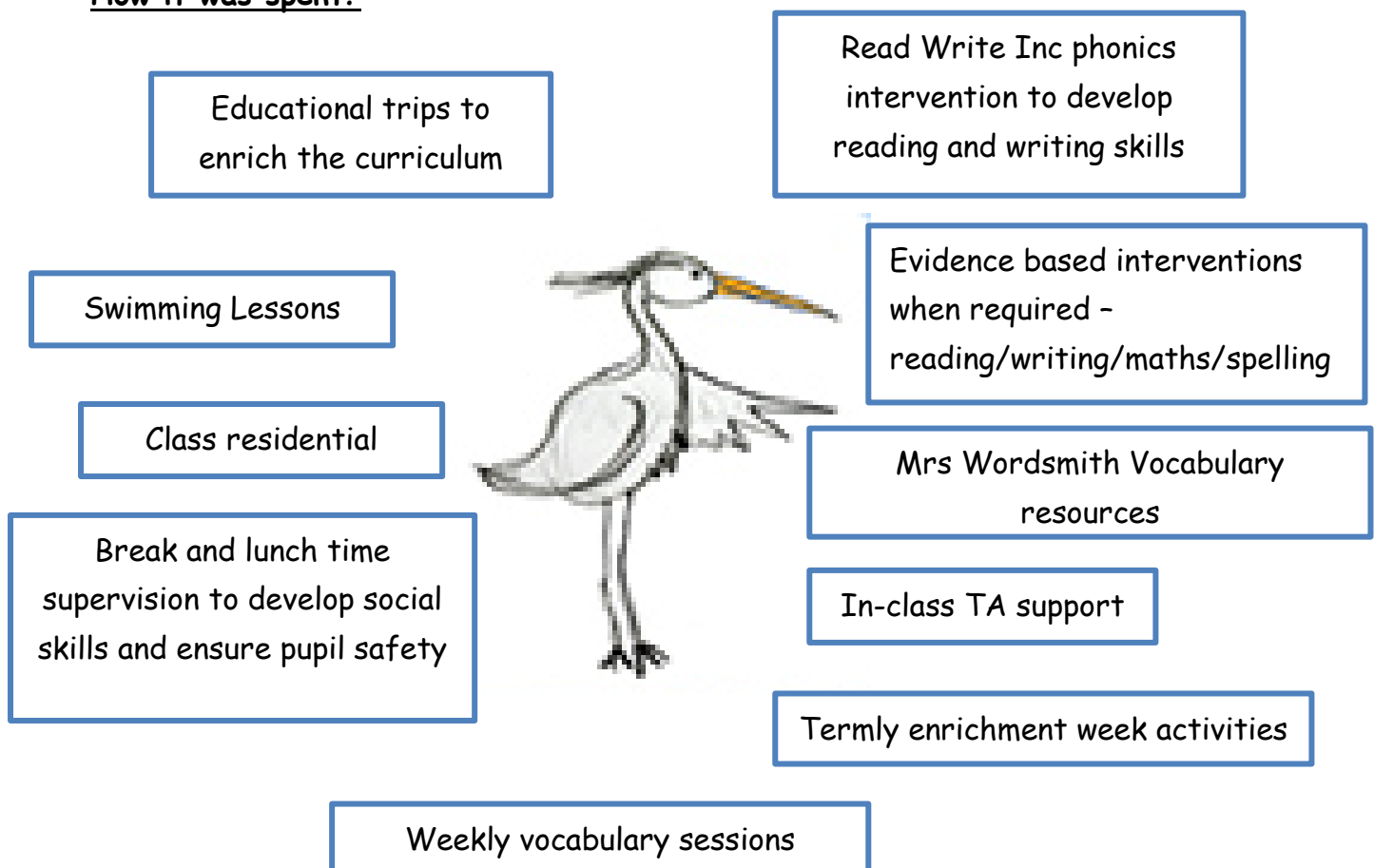
Pupil Premium Grant

During the financial year September 2020-July 2021 the school received a total of £24,520 Pupil Premium Funding. Children eligible for this funding made up 11% of the school population.

This funding is based on the school's data taken from the January 2020 Census. It relates to 18 pupils receiving Primary Deprivation Premium (£24,210), 1 pupil receiving Service Premium (£310) and 0 pupil receiving Adopted from Care Premium (£0). During this year, Primary Deprivation Premium was allocated at a rate of £1,345 per pupil, Service Premium at a rate of £310 per pupil and Adopted Premium at £2345.

The school also received 'Covid Catch-up funding' of £13,200 (please see separate catch-up funding document).

Impact of Pupil Premium Grant

Data from KS1/KS2 teacher assessments - July 2021 (teacher assessment due to Covid-19). A large proportion of our year 6 pupils eligible for pupil premium funding were also on our SEND register or being closely monitored due to SEND concerns.
