Somerset Big Tent



This week I would like to signpost you to The Somerset Big Tent programme. This is an umbrella under which all children and young people's mental health and emotional wellbeing services delivered by the voluntary and community sector in Somerset will be co-produced with children, young people and parents.

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The Big Tent initiative was devised by Young Somerset, Somerset Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) and Public Health to develop an alliance approach and act as the foundation for creating a new emotional wellbeing service delivered by locality-based children and young people’s Wellbeing Practitioners.

The Somerset Big Tent website, which launched on 30 November, provides an online space for children and young people and their parents and guardians to know what wellbeing support is available in the area. You can navigate the support based on the feelings, type of support, location, age and level of Quality Assurance to ensure that they can discover support options which are suitable for them. Somerset Big Tent is a Voluntary Community Social Enterprise alliance helping children and young people build their wellbeing, funded by NHS Somerset Clinical Commissioning Group and facilitated by Young Somerset.
