



Religious Education (RE) Curriculum

We follow the locally agreed syllabus for Somerset created by the Somerset Advisory Council on Religious Education 'Awareness Mystery and Value (AMV). This scheme teaches children about the different religions and beliefs and practices.

The coverage below allows our family of schools to work collaboratively. Each school can plan and deliver each unit in their own way using resources of their choice. Beyond the content outlined below, each school has the flexibility to plan and deliver their own units of work.

Key Stage One

Children across our primary schools will be taught Christianity and one other religion which is Judaism.

Non-religious views such as Humanism are also be represented.

Children are encouraged to talk openly, listen respectfully, and explore the values of understanding and awareness.

Key Stage Two

Children across our primary schools will be taught Christianity plus three other religions which are Hinduism, Islam or Judaism.

Non-religious views such as Humanism are also be represented.

Children are encouraged to talk openly, listen respectfully, and explore the values of tolerance and respect.
