Curriculum information:

An outline of this term's curriculum accompanies this letter. This term, PE will be on **Tuesday afternoons**. Pupils should arrive to school in their school uniforms. They will get changed before PE and then return home in their PE kits.

Homework information:

Please refer to our school's policy for further information and guidance regarding homework.

Reading - Please date and sign to record reading at home (5x10 minutes per week). Reading logs may also be used for messages regarding important messages - such as different after school pick-ups - or notes you would like to pass on. Reading logs will be collected every morning to check daily reading. A record of reading 5 days a week will earn a golden ticket. One golden ticket will be picked at random every half term to win a token for our NEW book vending machine!

Spellings - Handed out on Tuesday to be practised in preparation for testing the following Tuesday.

English Homework - To be handed in on a Tuesday at the latest for marking. Given out on Tuesday and marked weekly.

Times tables on TTRockstars (maths homework) - Children will have times tables to target every week using TTRockstars. These times tables are to be practised regularly (5x10 minutes per week) in preparation for testing in school each Friday.

Please log TTRockstars practise in your reading log. Reading logs will be collected every morning to check TTRockstars practise.
