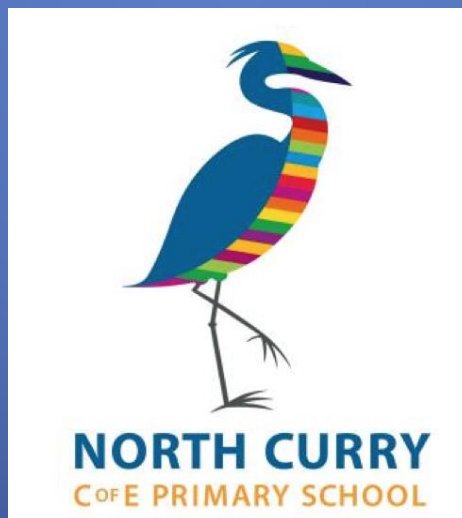

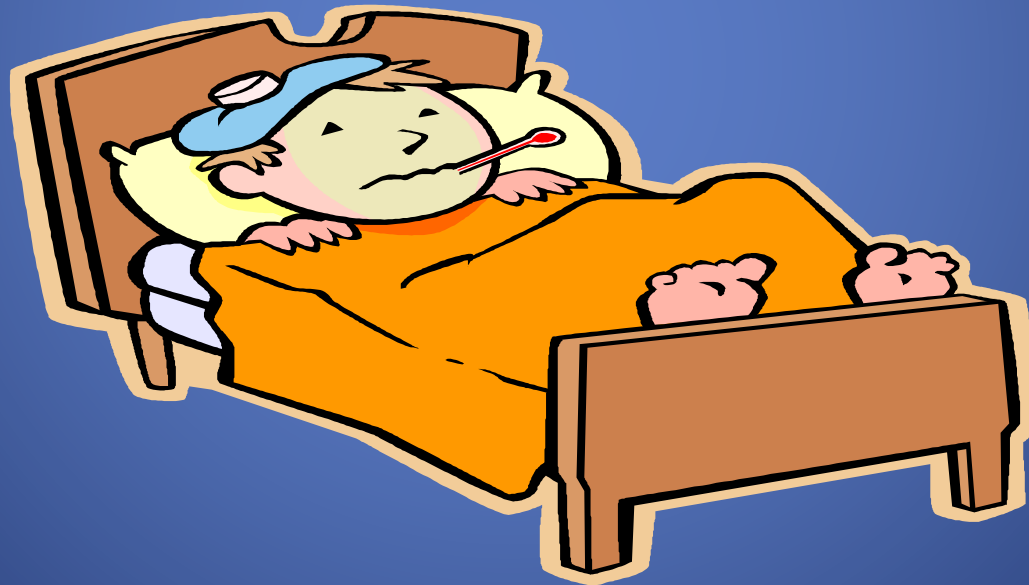

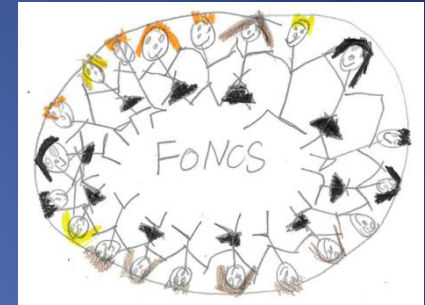


FONCS- Friends of North Curry School

We are parents and carers working together to raise funds to provide valuable enrichment to the school community.

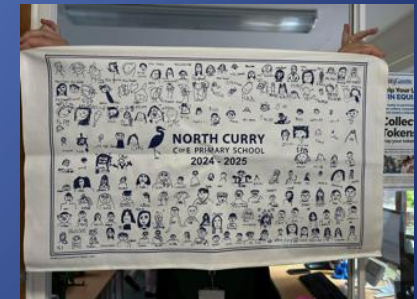
Our recent events have included an apple picking afternoon with games and cakes, discos for the children, a sponsored Santa Run, a quiz evening and the cream teas at the May Fair.

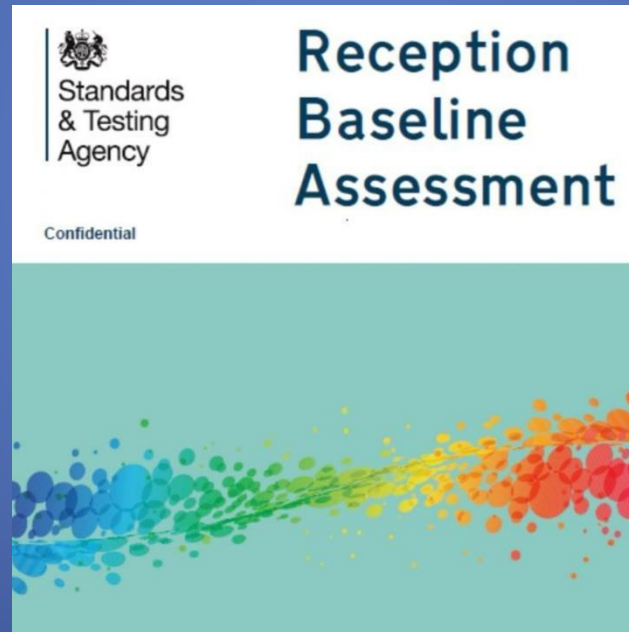


Minnow Class EYFS curriculum

3:10 – End of the Day

Helping at home

Before school begins:

- **Independence, getting dressed, putting shoes and jumpers on/off, toileting independently**
- **Reading/ sharing stories**
- **Learning to recognise your child's name**

When school starts:

- **Learning phonics sounds and key words**
- **Encouraging correct letter formation and pencil grip**
- **Discussing what your child has been doing in school**
